(M) = Microfiber Fabric Clean Ability
(A) = Aniline - Highest Quality Leather Available. Also known as "Naked" leather, these hides take the dye process much like natural wood takes a stain. Different parts of the hide will take on a different look of the dye color.
(O) = Oil Pull Up - Basically is Aniline leather with a wax or oil coating that is applied to the surface that gives the leather a unique feel, appearance, and response to wear.
(P) = Protected - Leather is coated with a protective color coating that shields the leather from stains and signs of age.
(N) = Nubuck - A pure aniline product, abraded to create a suede-like nap with a soft feel. Little or no protective coating; shows all natural markings and character of the hide. Varies in shade and texture from panel to panel.
